Demerit points for speeding in a school zone (fines also apply)

60 VIC ¹ | QLD ¹
1. On roads where the normal speed limit is 80km/h or higher.

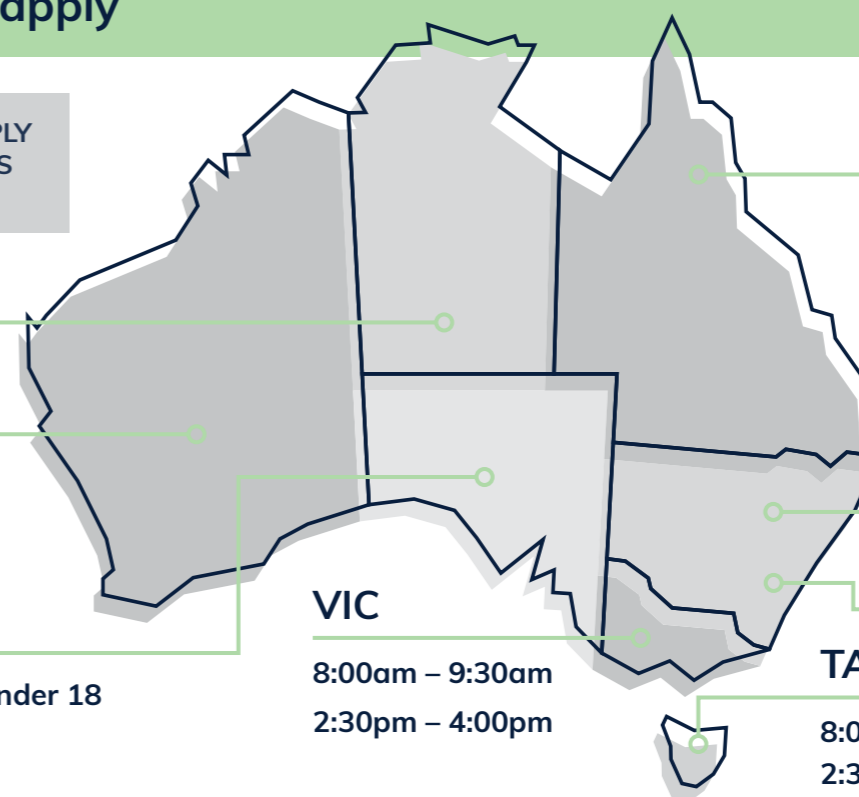
